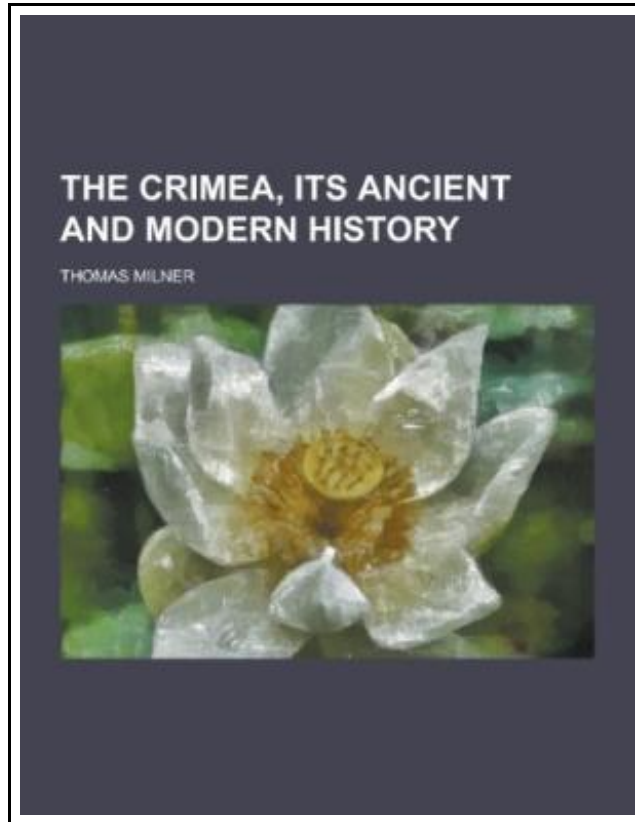

The civil capital of the Crimea, the residence of the governor, and the seat of the government offices and tribunals, Simferopol, is situated in the heart of the peninsula, on the hilly tract which forms the boundary between the mountains and the steppe. The site renders it a kind of rallying point for the inhabitants of both regions. On the one hand, to the south, the well-defined form of the Tchadir-dagh is seen to advantage, and, in the opposite direction, the apparently interminable plain. The city stands on SIMFEROPOL. 337 the banks of the Salghir, which has here cut for itself a deep channel in the shelly limestone, and flows through a valley filled with masses of trees, irrigating meadows, vineyards, and beautiful orchards. It consists of two portions, old and new, Tatar and Russian, closely connected, yet quite distinct, and thus answers to the meaning of its Greek name, the double city. Simferopol is about 40 miles from Sebastopol, 90 from Perekop, 950 from Moscow, and 1400 from St. Petersburg. The...
